Classroom Learning plus On the Job Training

Komatsu Equipment offers two options for training to be a technician:

- Komatsu Advanced Career Training (ACT) program at Oklahoma State University in Okmulgee, OK
- Komatsu Equipment Apprentice Program

Both programs combine classroom learning with on the job training, and Komatsu Equipment offers financial assistance, based on need, plus paid internships under either option. You earn an associates degree under the ACT program, and both teach you the specialized skills you need to excel as a technician for Komatsu Equipment. With both programs, you will learn the basics of heavy equipment diagnostics, maintenance and repair.

Classes

At either program you'll take classes in the following areas:

- Basic and advanced engines
- Hydraulics and electrical systems
- Transmissions
- Air conditioning
- Undercarriages for hydraulic excavators and crawler dozers
- Parts and service publications

Oklahoma State University Program

The Komatsu ACT Program at OSU in Okmulgee, OK requires six semesters. Half of each semester is spent in the classroom, and the other half is on-site at a Komatsu Equipment location, applying classroom knowledge to actual on the job situations as a paid intern.

Komatsu Equipment Apprentice Program

New technicians in the Komatsu Equipment Technician Program spend two years gaining experience in the classroom, in the shop, and in the field. The program is divided into three areas—rebuilding equipment in the shop, servicing machinery in the shop, and servicing machinery in the field. Technicians are required to complete six introductory classes, six machine specific classes, and MSHA New Miner Training. Classes are held at the Salt Lake City branch or Komatsu's training center in Cartersville, GA.
